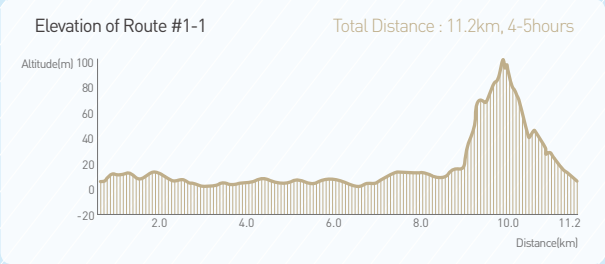

Route #1-1 U-do Olle

Shaped like a sprawled-out cow, U-do exemplifies the essence of Jeju's scenery with endless green fields, black stone walls, and lighthouses. The largest of the 62 islets surrounding Jeju Island, U-do offers a trail where you can enjoy the indigo ocean and the magnificent view throughout the year. Past the Hill of Soemultong(puddle for cattle), walk alongside the old stone walls that are still preserved in their original form, and enjoy the rye, barley and peanuts growing on the trail. The newly opened Jeju Olle Trail route has a bypass through the water reservoir, where they convert sea water to fresh water, whereas the earlier U-do bong(peak) trail heads straight up to the observatory. The trail cuts along the wide expanse surrounded by fine field of poppies and crimson clovers.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si 1) Take Bunyeong-ro #710(Jeju-Seongsan) at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to Seongsan Harbor(80 mins) → Take Ferry going to Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor(10~15 mins) in order to enter U-do

2) Take Intra-city #701(East bound intra-city bus, via Seongsan) to Seongsan Harbor Entrance(85 mins) → Take Ferry going to Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor(10~15 mins) in order to enter U-do

From Seogwipo-si Take intra-city bus #701(East bound intra-city bus) at Seogwi Intercity Bus Terminal to Seongsan Harbor Entrance(85 mins) → Walk for 15 minutes to Seongsan Harbor → Take Ferry going to Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor(10~15 mins) in order to enter U-do

You may get to Udo in 15 minutes by ferry at Seongsan Harbor heading to either Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor. Ferry runs every hour.

- Ferry Sailing Hours(from Seongsan Harbor to Udo): 8:00AM ~ 6:30PM

- Ferry Sailing Hours(from Udo Harbor to Seongsan): 7:00AM ~ 6:00PM

- Fare: KRW 5,500(adult, tax included)

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Take ferry heading to Seongsan Harbor either at Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor(10~15 mins) → 1) Take Bunyeong-ro Bus # 710(Jeju-Seongsan Harbor) to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal at Seongsan Harbor(80 mins) 2) Walk for 15 minutes to Seongsan Harbor Entrance → Take intra-city bus #701(East bound intra-city bus, via Seongsan) at Seongsan Harbor Entrance station to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(85 mins)

To Seogwipo-si Take ferry heading to Seongsan Harbor either at Cheonjin Harbor or Haumokdong Harbor(10~15 mins) → Walk for 15 minutes to Seongsan Harbor Entrance → Take intra-city bus # 701(East bound intra-city bus, via Seongsan) at Seongsan Harbor Entrance station to Seogwi Intercity Bus Terminal(85 mins)

Attractions

Hagosudong Beach Beach with Udo-bong(peak) on its background, the clean and white sandy beach is illuminated by numerous fishing boats during the summer dusk.

Hongjodangoe Haebin(white coral) Beach The beach is located in the west of U-do. Red algae on rocks have created this beautiful and clear-white beach by those white secretions, mingled with exotic seashells. This particular scenery is only found here in South Korea, thus the place was designated as the Natural Monument No. 483 in 2004.

Rye field U-do has several places for rye cultivation, commonly used as ingredients for whisky or beer. Golden beauty of rye during May sways the entire U-do.

Crimson clover & great scarlet poppy colony Known to thrive on barren lands, crimson clovers and field poppies paint U-do with shades of red every May through June.

Hill of Soemultong(puddle for cattle) This is a place where the cows from grazing ranges used to quench their thirst.

Udo-bong(peak) A regular shaped cliff forms neat layers of stone bricks here, as if they have been laid upon one by another. It is the head of the Udo. The emerald-green grass and the indigo blue sea make a perfect color combination, creating scenery that represents the beauty of the island.
