Except for two oreums in the beginning, the route mostly follows a coastal road and sand flat. Even the oreums are not too challenging.

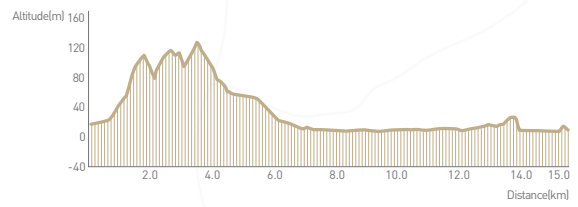

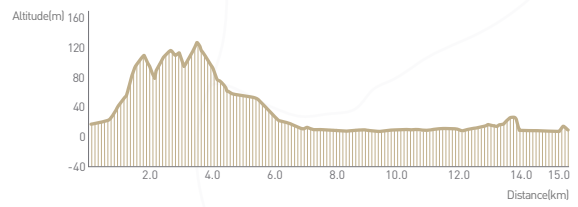

Route #1 Siheung – Gwangchigi Olle

Jeju Olle' first route. It is "Oreum – Badang Olle", connecting an oreum and the ocean. The route starts at a petite yet pretty Siheung Elementary School and connects to evergreen field, Malmi Oreum and Al Oreum for panoramic scenery of Seongsan Ilchulbong(sunrise peak) and U-do. Green fields with Jeju's signature black stone wall resemble patchwork of colorful cloths. Walk past Jongdal-ri salt flats and Siheung-ri coastal road and you will arrive at Sumapo Beach with an impressive view of Seongsan Ilchulbong. And the color of the ocean at the finishing point of Gwangchigi Beach is simply stunning.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si Take east bound Intercity Bus #701 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Siheung-ri Bus Stop(90 minutes). Face the bus stop and walk 50m towards Jongdal-ri to find the starting point

From Seogwipo-si Take east bound Intra-city bus #701 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Siheung-ri Bus Stop(100 minutes). Face the bus stop and walk 100m towards Siheung-ri to find the starting point

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Take east bound Intra-city Bus #701 at the bus stop on the left side of the road to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(90 minutes, via Seongsan).

To Seogwipo-si Take east bound Intra-city Bus #701 at the bus stop across the driveway on the right side to go to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal(90 minutes, via Seongsan).

Attractions

Malmi Oreum Also known as Dusan-bong(peak), Malmi Oreum(small inactive volcano) resembles a horse head. Below the oreum is the vast field of Seongsan-po. There is Seongsan Ilchulbong in the front and U-do(island) on the left.

Al Oreum Al Oreum looks just like a bird egg as its name suggests - 'Al' in Korean means an egg. Here, you can see oreums in the East, including Darangshe Oreum, along with Seongsan-po, Seongsan Ilchulbong and Hallasan(mountain).

Seongsan Ilchulbong Cliff on three sides, it is a volcano at the end of the Seongsan peninsula. Its name 'Seongsan' comes from its magnificent look resembling a castle, a crater surrounded by 99 rock peaks. It is well known as the place to go for sunrise.

Jongdal-ri Beach Small yet pretty beach with lots of seaweed and clam, Jongdal-ri Beach boasts the emerald green sea. Clams from the beach taste good. There are shower facilities, so take some time off the course to enjoy the beach during the summer.

Gwangchigi Beach You will find rock fields at low tide and the name Gwangchigi comes after the look resembling wilderness. Gwangchigi in Jeju dialect means a wide rock(Bille). There are lots of seaweed, shellfish and fish.
