

# Jeju Olle Route

## 10-1 Gapa-do Olle



**Total Distance: 4.3km**

**Total Time: 1~2 hour**

**Low Difficulty**

Total distance is less than 5km and there is no uphill road in Gapa-do. Recommended for all visitors.

**Wheelchair Accessible Area: All accessible**

## Route #10-1 Gapa-do Olle

Gapa-do(island) is the lowest inhabited island in Korea. The highest point is at 70 feet. Very interesting to note, Korea's highest point, Halla-san(mountain), and the lowest point, Gapa-do(island), exist in Jeju Island. It takes about an hour to stroll through the entire Gapa-do(island). So, it is easy to say that Gapa-do(island) Olle is not for hike. Rather, it is for a break. It is a great place to ease the fatigue built from spending days of hiking Jeju Olle Trail. Gapa-do(island) is the island for light walk and rest. It is where you can fully charge before setting out on another route.

### Transportation

#### Direction to the starting point

**From Jeju-si** 1) Take English Education City Bus #755 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to Moseulpo-hang(harbor) bus stop(60 minutes) → Take a ship at Moseulpo-hang(harbor) to enter the island(25 minutes, operates 4 times a day)

2) Take Pyeonghwa-ro Bus #750-1~4 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Moseulpo Intercity Bus Terminal(60 minutes) → Take a ship at Moseulpo-hang(harbor) to enter the island(25 minutes, operates 4 times a day)

**From Seogwipo-si** Take west bound intra-city bus #702 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Hamo-ri bus stop(45 minutes) → Walk 50m toward Boseong-ri → Walk 5 minutes to the ocean on the right side at crossroads to find Moseulpo-hang(harbor) → Take a ship at Moseulpo-hang(harbor) to enter the island(25 minutes, operates 4 times a day)

\* Gapa-do bound ship departs Moseulpo-hang(harbor) 4 times a day at 9 am, 11 am, 2 pm and 4 pm. The operation schedule can vary to the weather condition. If you are interested in staying in Gapa-do(island), please make sure to check the time and weather conditions in advance.

\* The operation details(ship or schedule) can vary to the weather conditions or company matters, so please check in advance.(Inquiries: 064-794-5490)

#### Direction from the Finishing point

**To Jeju-si** Walk 15 minutes to Gapa-do Hang(harbor) → Take a ship to Moseulpo-hang(harbor)(25 minutes, operates 4 times a day)

1) Take English Education City Bus #755 at Moseulpo-hang(harbor) bus stop to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(60 minutes)

2) Walk straight for 10 minutes from Moseulpo-hang(harbor) to go to Moseulpo Intercity Bus Terminal → Take Pyeonghwa-ro #750-1~4 to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(60 minutes)

**To Seogwipo-si** Walk 15 minutes to Gapa-do Hang(harbor) → Take a ship to Moseulpo-hang(harbor)(25 minutes, operates 4 times a day) → Walk for 5 minutes from Moseulpo-hang(harbor) to Nonghyup Crossroads and walk another 50m to the right side → Take west bound intra-city bus #702 at Hamo2-ri bus stop to go to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal

### Attractions

**Barley Field** There is a 140-acre large barley field in Gapa-do(island). You will feel like a time traveler, while hiking the trail in the field between late winter to early summer.

**Jipdam and Batdam(house walls and field walls)** Stonewalls are like a piece of art in Gapa-do. Every stone comes from water. If you open up to the stories told by the stonewalls, you can listen to the history of Gapa-do.

**Halmang-dang(shrine)** There are two Halmang-dangs in Gapa-do in Sangdong and Hadong. Halmang is an honorary title for Jeju's God.

**Mara-do(island)** It is most beautiful, when seen from Gapa-do(island).
