12 Mureung - Yongsu Olle

The route begins with flat farm road, connected to Nongnam-bong(peak), Suweol-bong(peak) and Dangsang-bong(peak). There also is boulder road by the beach.

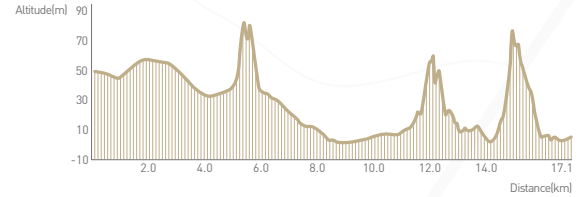

Route #12

Mureung – Yongsu Olle

First Jeju Olle Trail route to connect all of Seogwipo-si along the coastlines up to Jeju-si. From Mureung 2-ri to Jeolbuam in Yongsu-pogu(port), beautiful sceneries of fields, ocean and oreums continue throughout the route. The horizon is hazy in the wide-open fields, and the deep sea sways in a glitter of jade. The Doguri(a wide container made by sculpting stone or wood to be use as a feed bucket for cows or pigs) resembles a mystic pond filled with seawater and seaweed. The view of the tidal waves pounding at these Doguris is magnificent.

The stone workers that created 'Ilgangjeong Badang Olle Trail' in Route #7 reconstruct-ed this path in front of the Sindo Beach with support from Seogwipo City. Pass through Suweol-bong(peak) and Eongal-gil(pathway), and go up Dangsan-bong(peak), while enjoying the great view of Chagwi-do(island), and you will end up at 'Saengyi Gijeong Badang Gil(named by Jeju Olle Foundation, meaning 'cliff with many birds').

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si Take Pyeonghwa-ro Bus #750-1~4 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to Mureung 2-ri Small Park bus stop(60 minutes) → Walk 30m backwards to find the main road → Turn left and walk another 110m to find Mureung 5-way intersection → Walk another 850m to find 2881 Jungangan Seo-ro and turn left → Walk 120m more to find the starting point

From Seogwipo-si Take west bound intra-city bus #702 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Inseong-ri bus stop(45 minutes) → Turn right at Goeul Diner in front of the traffic light and you will find another Inseong-ri bus stop → Take Bus #950 to Jwagi-dong bus stop → Walk 200m backwards to find 2881 Jungangan Seo-ro and turn left → Walk 120m more to find the starting point

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Walk for 20 minutes toward Route #13 → Cross the road at Choonghon-

top(tower) Crossroads and walk 50m to the left → Take west bound intra-city bus #702 to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(85 minutes)

To Seogwipo-si Walk for 20 minutes toward Route #13 → Walk 20m to the left from Choonghon-top(tower) Crossroads → Take west bound intra-city bus #702 at Yongsu-ri Choonghon-myoji(graveyard) bus stop to go to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal(85 minutes)

Attractions

Suweol-bong(peak) This parasitic volcanic cone, though only 77 meters above the sea level, boasts a superb view of southwestern Jeju Island; facing the sea to the north is the Chagwi group of Chagwi-do(island), Juk-do and Noon-seom(island) with Dangsan-bong(peak) rising immediately above the port. The seaward cliff below Suweol-bong is called "Eongal".

Dangsan-bong(peak) Its original name is Dang Oreum. There used to be a shrine at the foot of the mountain, called Sagwi. Some mistakenly called Sagwi as Chagwi and the name became Chagwi Oreum later on.

Chagwi-do(island) This is the largest uninhabited island in Jeju Province. 10-minute boat ride from Jagunae-pogu(port). Chagwi-do(island) is a group of of Juk-do(island), Jisili-seom(island), Wa-do(island) and some smaller islets. Chagwi-do(island) is well known for a type of squid locally harvested and sun/wind dried.
