18-1 Chuja-do Olle



Total Distance: 18.2km

Total Time: 6~8 hour

Difficulty: Medium

You can go up and down many of the beautiful peaks such as the Bongle-san(mountain), the Mukri-gogae(hill), Sindae-san(mountain), Yechori Gijeong and Donda-san(mountain). It takes a day to get the full grasp of this route. Sunset at Bongle-san is absolutely stunning.

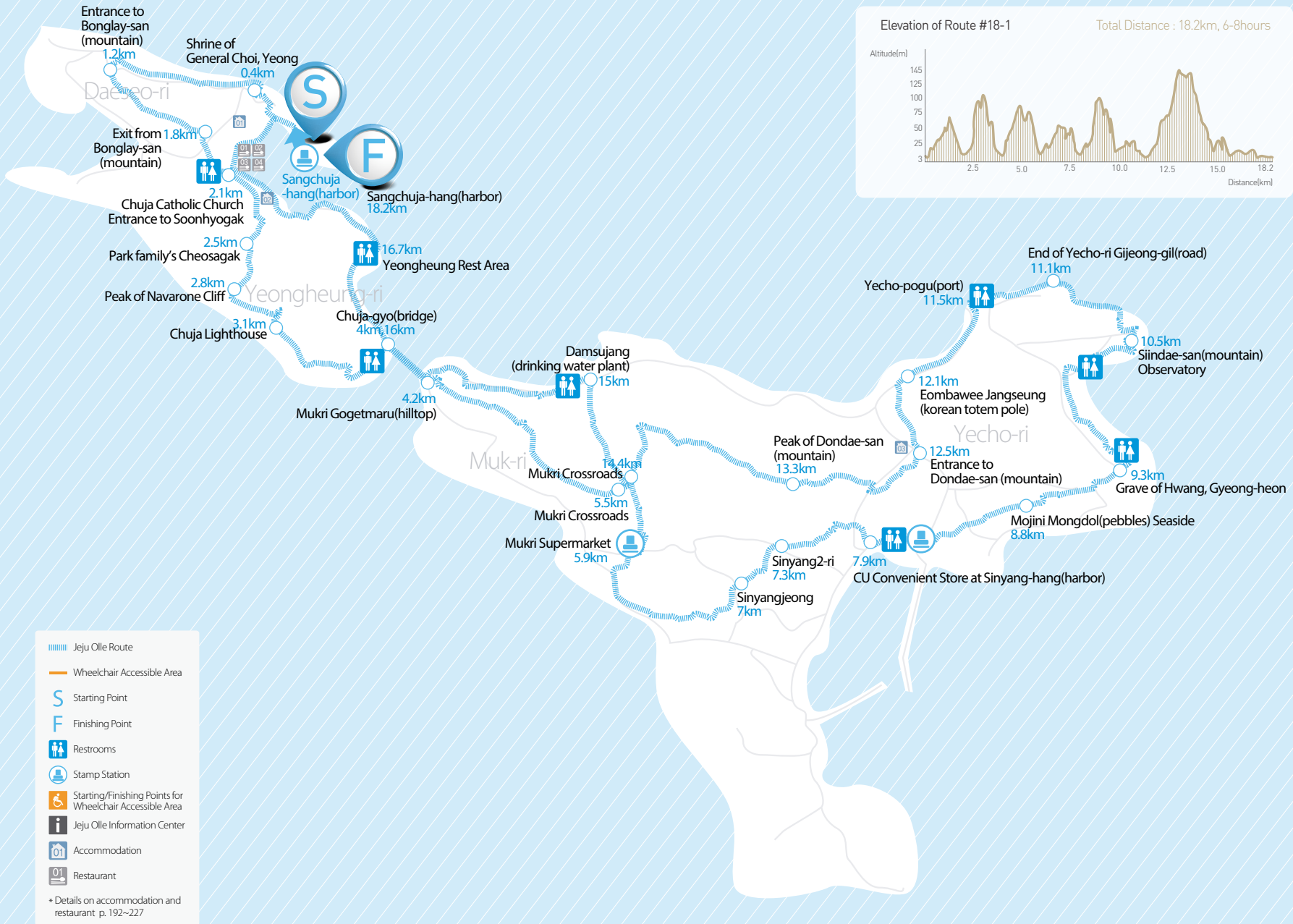


Restaurants for Lunch

Route #18-1 Chuja-do Olle

Chuja-do(island) is not just one island. There are 4 inhabited and 38 uninhabited islands in Chuja-do(island). Mountains rising from the sea; the varying levels of the island make one feel as if standing inside mountains than an island. The blue sea seems infinite below the mountain peaks and, as you walk and look around, you are presented with new scenery of the sea and the mountains. The Jeju Olle Trail reveals every hidden beauty of Chuja-do(island), as you pass the peaks of Sangchuja and Hachuja. Encountering a quiet and peaceful forest path in the ocean is entertaining and, with the energy from joy, you will be pumped up to climb another oreum.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si 1) Take intercity Bus #500 from Jeju International Airport to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop(12 minutes) → Go to the bus stop in front of Gimhap Cheonguk on the opposite side in direction of Jungang-ro Rotary. Take intercity bus #92 to go to Jeju Ferry Terminal(7 minutes) → Take the ship to go to Chuja-hang(harbor)

2) Take intercity bus #95 at Jeju International Airport or Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to International Terminal → Go to Jeju Ferry Terminal(10 minutes) → Take the ship to go to Chuja-hang(harbor)

From Seogwipo-si Take Jungmun Express Bus #782, 782-1, 782-2 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Jeju City Hall bus stop(80 minutes) → Walk 300m forward → Cross the road in direction of the ocean and walk 200m to Gwangyang bus stop → Take intercity bus #92 to go to Jeju Ferry Terminal(7 minutes) → Take the ship to go to Chuja-hang(harbor)

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si 1) Take the ship at Chuja-hang(harbor) to go to Jeju Ferry Terminal → Go to International Terminal bus stop(10 minutes) → Take intercity bus #95 to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal or Jeju International Airport(30 minutes)

2) Take intercity bus #92 at Jeju Ferry Terminal to go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop(7 minutes) → Go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop next to Hyundai Pharmacy across → Take intercity bus #500 to go to Jeju International Airport(12 minutes)

To Seogwipo-si Take the ship at Chuja-hang(harbor) to go to Jeju Ferry Terminal → Take intercity bus #92 to go to Gwangyang Crossroads bus stop(13 minutes) → Walk 160m forward → Cross the street at Gwangyang Crossroads toward Hallasan(mountain) and walk another 100m to Jeju City Hall bus stop(for Intercity Bus) → Take Jungmun Express Bus #782 to go to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal(80 minutes)

Attractions

Shrine of General Choi, Yeong On the 23rd year of the reign of King Gongmin during Koryeo Dynasty(1374), General Choi, Yeong, while on his way to Jeju Island to suppress the revolt of Mok Ho, encountered severe winds and waves and, thus, was forced to seek refuge at Chuja-do(island) and wait until the winds calmed down. General Choi, Yeong who was then staying at Jeomsangot, taught the residents how to make fishing nets and catch fish. Their lifestyle improved by far accordingly and they built up this shrine to honor General Choi, Yeong's grace. Within the shrine lies an ancestral tablet that reads 'National Conversant General Choi, Yeong' and rituals are done every spring and summer to commemorate his contributions.

Mojini Mongdol Coast In Chuja-do(island), you can find round pebble fields here and there off the coast. It extends as far as 100m from Mojini and people can enjoy sea bathing off its shores.
