The route is not short, but mostly easy. There are walkways for local residents, on Sara-bong(peak) and Byeoldo-bong(peak).

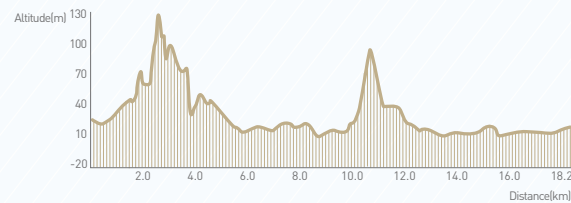

Route #18

Sanjicheon – Jocheon Olle

Jeju Olle Trail Route #18 begins at Dongmun Rotary, which is located at the heart of downtown Jeju-si. Take a walk along Sanji-cheon(stream) yard in Dongmun Rotary and toward the ocean. The route continues to a man-made trail, but water birds are sometimes seen flying on Sanji-cheon(stream).

Sara-bong(peak) and Byeoldo-bong(peak), like jewels in downtown Jeju. Sara-bong is not too hard to climb, and you still get picturesque sights of downtown Jeju-si, the sea and Halla-san(mountain). Downhill road from Sara-bong is truly magnificent for the combination of silver grass and the sea. The trail is followed by a vacant area of stonewalls. This used to be Goneul-dong Village. Completely burnt down during the April 3 Incident, a sad history of Jeju Island. The route extends to Wondang-bong(peak), where the countryside is best exemplified, 5-story stone tower of the old Wondang-sa(temple) and to the old path going to Shinchon for food after participating in rituals. And we are back to the ocean. Breathtaking coastal scenery follows from Sibi-koji to Dakmoru. The long journey to this city is a trip to nature, the very reason you left your home for a chance to mark your presence in the grand picture.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si 1) Take intercity bus #100 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Dongmun Rotary bus stop → Walk 50m toward the market entrance → Across the road is Sanjicheon Plaza and you will find the starting point below the tree

2) Take intercity bus #500 at Jeju International Airport to go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop → Walk for 7 minutes toward Dongmun Rotary / Sanjicheon Plaza on the other side → You will find the starting point below the tree

3) Take intercity bus #92 at International Dock to go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop(10 minutes) → Walk for 7 minutes toward Dongmun Rotary / Sanjicheon Plaza on the other side → Cross the road and you will find the starting point below the tree

From Seogwipo-si Take Jungmun Express Bus #782, 782-1 or 782-2 at Seogwipo

Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Jeju District Court bus stop(70 minutes) → Take intercity Bus #10, 28, 2, 3, 43, 43-1 or 1001 to go to Dongmun Rotary bus stop → Cross the road and you will find the starting point below the tree

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si 1) Take intercity Bus #10 at Jocheon Manse Dongsan(mound) bus stop to go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop(20 minutes) → Go to Jungang-ro Crossroads bus stop in front of Hyundai Pharmacy on the other side → Take Intra-city Bus #500 to go to Jeju International Airport(10 minutes)

2) Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Jocheon Manse Dongsan(mound) bus stop to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(30 minutes)

To Seogwipo-si Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Jocheon Stadium bus stop on the other side to go to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal(135 minutes)

Attractions

Sara-bong(peak) This place offers a panoramic view of downtown Jeju. Sunset is too beautiful, called Sabongnakjo and selected as one of the 10 scenic views. Sara-bong(peak)'s big cone pine forest received "Beautiful Harmony" Award in the [Citizen's forest] category at the '11th National Competition of Beautiful Forests' in 2010.

Jocheon Manse Dongsan Among the Manse movements staged against Japanese colonialists in Jocheon region from March 21 to 24, 1819, the first was organized at Mimit Dongsan(mound), which was renamed as Manse Dongsan. Second to the fourth were organized in Jocheon marketplace where the public could gather.
