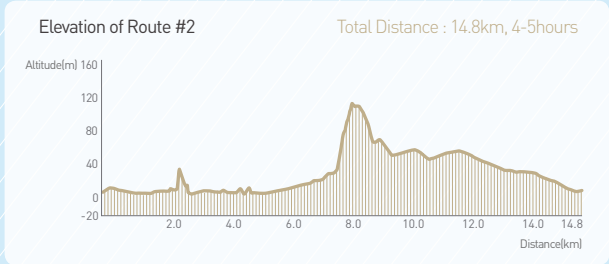
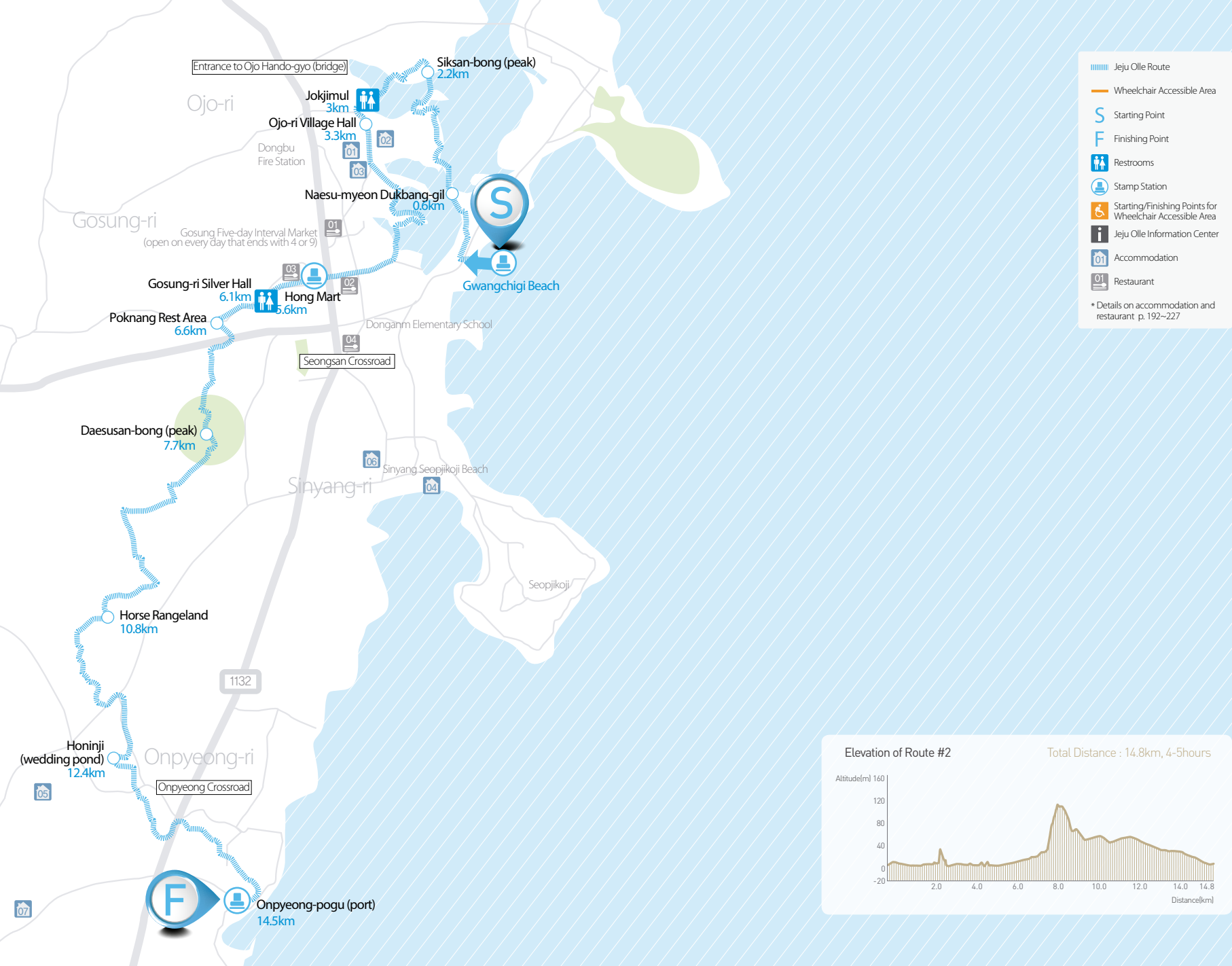


Restaurants for Lunch

Route #2 Gwangchigi – Onpyeong Olle

Olle begins at Gwangchigi Beach in Seongsan-ri and goes on to Gosung, Daesusan-bong(peak), Honinji and the seashore of Onpyeong-ri. There is a wide array of eye-catching roads on the way – seaside walk along the emerald green ocean, field path around a reservoir and a quiet mountain path. At the top of Daesusan-bong(peak), you are opened to the scenery of the beautiful Eastern Jeju, from Siheung to Gwangchigi Beach. You also pass by Onpyeong-ri Beach, where Go, Yang and Bu, the legendary three founders of Korea in Samseong Myth, welcomed three princess of from Heaven, and Honinji, where they had the wedding.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Gwangchigi Bus Stop(90 minutes) → Cross the crosswalk in the direction of the bus route, turn left and walk another 50m toward the starting point.

From Seogwipo-si Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Gwangchigi Bus Stop(90 minutes) → Walk 50m toward a gazebo on the left and you will find the starting point.

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Turn away from the ocean and walk for 10 minutes until you meet the main road → Turn right and walk for another 60m → Take bus #701 at the Onpyeong Primary School Bus Stop to the Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(90 minutes).

To Seogwipo-si Turn away from the ocean and walk for 10 mins until you meet the main road → Cross the road and walk for another 100m to the left → Take bus # 701 at the Onpyeong Primary School Bus Stop to the Seogwi Intercity Bus Terminal(90 minutes).

Attractions

Siksan-bong(peak) Ojo-ri Beach was often attacked by Japan back in the Koryo Dynasty. The General then gathered everyone from the town to make an oreum look like a huge pile of military foods. Japanese raiders from afar were completely fooled and never tried plotting an attack afterwards. We started calling these oreums Siksan-bong since then. It is also known as Rock Oreum, as there is a rock at the top that looks like a general.

Daesusan-bong(peak) The waterway between two oreums in Gosung-ri split both ways. With the waterway in between, the larger oreum is called Keunmul-mwe and the smaller oreum Jakeummul-mwe. Dasesusan-bong(peak) is a Chinese word for Keunmul-mwe, the larger oreum. At the top of Daesusan-bong(peak), you are opened to the scenery of the beautiful Eastern Jeju, from Siheung-ri of Jeju Olle Route #1 to Gwangchigi Beach.

Honinji It is where Go, Yang and Bu from Samseong Myth, the legendary three founders of Korea, married the three princesses from Heaven. There is a cave dwelling, which is said to be a home for the three newlyweds.
