## 21 Hado - Jongdal Olle



**Total Distance: 10.1km**

**Total Time: 3~4 hour**

**Difficulty: Medium**

The route is mostly flat, except for Jimi-bong(peak). The view at Jimi-bong(peak) is invaluable, but you can always take detours if you don't feel well.

**Finishing Point: Jongdal Badang**



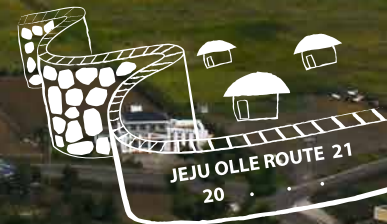

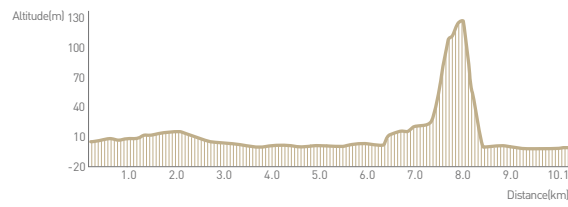

## Route #21

# Hado – Jongdal Olle

You get to experience the nature of Eastern Jeju. Start out at a village, facing the ocean of Gujwa-eup, and follow the road across the field, walk along the sea route and climb an oreum. You are walking toward the Eastern end of Jeju. The walk began at Siheung of Route #1 and the itinerary ends at Jimi-bong of Route #21. Look 360 degrees around yourself to find Jeju. You will notice the starting points of the journey, Siheung Elementary School, Malmi Oreum, carrot and potato fields, and the blue Jeju with Seongsan Ilchul-bong(peak) and a group of oreums in the East, Yongnoonyi Oreum and Darangshe Oreum. Spread out your times and memories from Jeju Olle Trail and you will realize that another beautiful scenery is here at the tip of this island. Down Jimi-bong and into the coast of Jongdal. This time, the journey is over at the small and gorgeous beach of Jongdal-ri. Let's get ready for the new beginning.

### Transportation

#### Direction to the starting point

**From Jeju-si** Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Sangdo-ri bus stop(70 minutes) → Walk 200m toward the ocean across and you will find the starting point at Haenyeo Museum

**From Seogwipo-si** Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Sangdo-ri bus stop(100 minutes) → Walk 200m toward the ocean across and you will find the starting point at Haenyeo Museum

#### Direction from the Finishing point

**To Jeju-si** Face away from the ocean and walk 1km toward the village → Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at the bus stop in front of Jongdal Elementary School to go to Jeju-si(70 minutes)

**To Seogwipo-si** Face away from the ocean and walk 1km toward the village → Take east bound intra-city bus #701 at the bus stop in front of Jongdal Elementary School to go to Seogwipo-si(90 minutes)

### Attractions

**Byeolbangjin** Set up a camp in Hado-ri and built a castle to defend the land from Japanese invaders approaching Oedo In 1510(Joongjong's 5th year of ruling, Chosun Dynasty). There were residences and armories inside the castle and three gates to the East, West and South. There is a saying that young men then had to work without foods due to poor harvest. You can see the entire castle now, thanks to the recently completed restoration project. #24 Heritage of Jeju's Special Self-Governing Province.

**Tokki-seom(island), Moonjuran(crinum) Habitat** It is a small island near Hado-ri Ocean. It is a crinum habitat. The island looked like rabbit in summer – turning white at full blossom. You can walk in and out of the island at low tide. Moonjuran or crinum is a sea plant of the south, evergreen herbaceous perennial of Amaryllidaceae. The white flower first blooms in July and covers the entire island in white by September. Tokki-seom(island) is the only Moojuran habitat in Korea. Moonjuran is #19 Heritage of Jeju's Special Self-Governing Province.

**Jimi-bong(peak)** It is an oreum at Jongdal-ri entrance. The way up the oreum is mostly stairways, steep but not long. At the peak, you get a panoramic view of bird sanctuary, U-do(island), Seongsan Ilchul-bong(peak), the East Sea of Jeju, the filed of Seongsan, Malmi Oreum, Al Oreum and a group of oreums in the East. The name 'Jimi' comes from its location, at the tail of Jeju Island. The head is at Dumo-ri Hangyeong-myeon. Altitude: 165.8m.

**Hado-ri Beach / Jongdal-ri Beach** Hado-ri and Jongdal-ri have small, clean and lovely beach. Both beaches have fine sand and outstanding sceneries. It is a great place for sea bathing as there aren't too many visitors.
