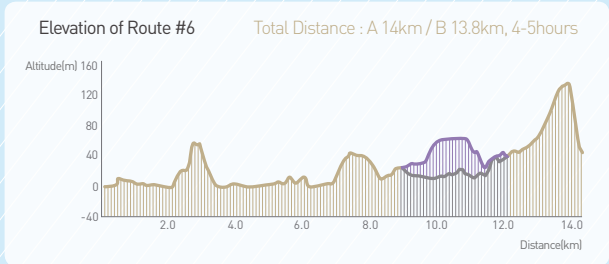
Restaurants for Lunch

Route #6 Soesokkak – Oedolgae Olle

It is a coastal and city Olle from Soesokkak, through the city of Seogwipo, Lee, Jung-seop Street, walkway above Cheonjiyeon Falls and to Oedolgae. Hike and experience the culture and nature of Seogwipo, such as Sogeummak(a place for baking salt) of the coast, vibrant life and culture of Seogwipo City and culture and Cheonjiyeon Falls Walkway, where you can encounter 5 kinds of Natural Heriatge. You can choose between the market Olle(Course A, 14km) and the coastal Olle(Course B, 13.5km). The two courses are separated at Lee, Jung-seop Residence and come together at the Poetry Park.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si 1) Take the Airport Limousine #600 at Jeju International Airport to go to Seogwipo KAL Hotel(90 minutes) → Take taxi to get to the starting point(10 minutes)
2) Take Namjo-ro Bus #730 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to go to Dure Villa bus stop(80 minutes) → Cross the road and walk 250m toward Seogwipo-si → Find a signboard that leads to Soesokkak on the left side of the bridge walk 15 minutes to find the starting point

From Seogwipo-si Take Namjo-ro Bus #730 at Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal(25 minutes) and change to east bound intra-city bus #701 to go to Dure Villa bus stop(25 minutes) → Walk 250m toward Seogwipo-si → Find a signboard that leads to Soesokkak on the left side of the bridge walk 15 minutes to find the starting point

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Walk 10m to Oedolgae bus stop on the right side to take intercity Bus #8 to go to East Central Rotary bus stop(10 minutes) → Walk 2 minutes to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal → Take Jungmun Express Bus #781, 781-1, 781-2 to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(70 minutes)

To Seogwipo-si Walk 10m to Oedolgae bus stop and take intercity Bus #8 to go to

Seogiwipo-si East Central Rotary bus stop(10 minutes)

Attractions

Sogeummak It's where people used to boil sea water to produce and store salt, when salt was too scarce. There used to be barracks for Sogeummak guards.

Lee, Jung-seop Art Gallery There is an art gallery next to Lee, Jung-seop Residence. Not too many of his works is on display, but there are love letters he exchanged with his life. You can listen to the song 'Seogwipo Chilsipri' in the lawn.

Oedolgae The name is for the rock that stands alone in the middle of the ocean. It is said that the rock was formed 1.5 million years ago at the volcano eruption. Aquamarine Ocean and pine forest nearby will leave you speechless.
