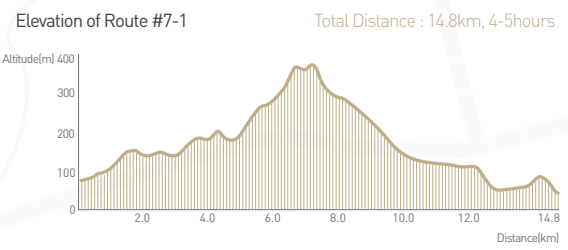
Restaurants for Lunch

Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal at Seogwipo

Route #7-1 World Cup Stadium – Oedolgae Olle

Hike the trail as breathing in and out the beauty of Jeju Jungsangan. The trail begins at Seogwipo World Cup Stadium and ends at Oedolgae through Jungsangan. You will find Hallasan over and Jeju's Southern Sea and the entire Seogwipo area below. Untraveled regions of Jungsangan surrounded by cliffs and natural warm-temperate forest are just striking. You pass by rice fields, quite rare in Jeju. It is a lot of fun to hike along the ridge between rice fields.

Transportation

Direction to the starting point

From Jeju-si 1) Take the Airport Limousine #600 at Jeju International Airport to go to World Cup Stadium bus stop(80 minutes) → Walk toward the World Cup Stadium entrance to find the starting point

2) Take Jungmun Express Bus #782, 782-1, 782-2 at Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal (70 minutes) → Walk toward the World Cup Stadium entrance to find the starting point

From Seogwipo-si Take intercity bus #1, 7, 110, 120, 130, 701,781, 781-1, 781-2, 930 at West Central Rotary bus stop to go to World Cup Stadium bus stop → Walk toward the World Cup Stadium entrance to find the starting point

Direction from the Finishing point

To Jeju-si Walk 10m toward Oedolgae bus stop on the right side and take intercity bus #8 to go to East Central Rotary bus stop(10 minutes) → Walk 2 minutes to Seogwipo Intercity Bus Terminal → Take Jungmun Express Bus #781, 781-1, 781-2 to go to Jeju Intercity Bus Terminal(70 minutes)

To Seogwipo-si Walk 10m toward Oedolgae bus stop on the right side and take intercity bus #8 to go to East Central Rotary bus stop(10 minutes)

Attractions

Ungtto Falls It is a hidden treasure beyond steep cliffs and dense forest. It is 160 feet tall. Its true value stands out, when there is no rainstorm.

Gogeun-san(mountain) It is an oreum surrounding New Town of Seogwipo-si. You get an open view from Mara-do(island) to Jigwi-do(island), the scenery of Jeju's Southern Sea and Seogwipo-si. This is the place to go for the night view of Seogwipo Chilsipri.

Oedolgae The name is for the rock that stands alone in the middle of the ocean. It is said that the rock was formed 1.5 million years ago at the volcano eruption. Aquamarine Ocean and pine forest nearby will leave you speechless.
